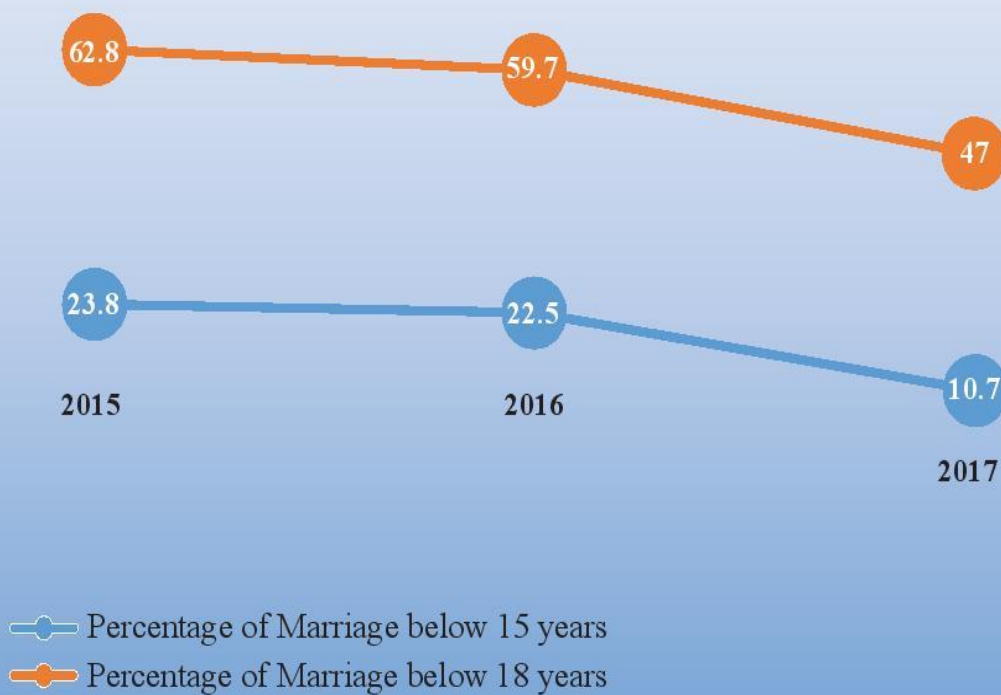

The government of Bangladesh is committed to achieve the fundamental rights described in the constitution of People's Republic of Bangladesh as well as the targets regarding The United Nation Convention on the Rights of the Child, CEDAW for women empowerment, the action plan of Beijing Declaration and the other goals regarding Beijing Declaration. The Ministry of Women and Children Affairs is implementing different programmes of the government with succession to involve women with main stream of development to implement the vision 2021 and 2041 under our Honorable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's dynamic leadership. The Child Marriage Restraint Act, 2017 and The National Plan of Action to End Child Marriage 2018-2030 was also initiated by this Ministry to establish the rights and development of women and children.

The Plan of Action shall be implemented by the lead of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs by involving different government and non-Government organizations, development associates, citizen's association and teenagers. 2018-2019 have been considered as foundation years of The National Plan of Action to End Child Marriage in the context of sustainable development goal taken by The United Nations in 2015. All the activities of the action plan has been divided into short, medium and long term programmes.

I believe, everybody will come forward to prevent child marriage from their own context. I also hope that, Bangladesh will be free from child marriage before the predetermined period by the implementation of The Nation Action Plan to End Child marriage.

Preface

The London Girl's Summit on 22 July 2014 has been given highest priority to the development of girl children. Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has made commitment in the Summit to end child marriage in Bangladesh by 2041. The child marriage below the age of 15 years will be eliminated and marriages between the ages of 15 and 18 years will be reduced by one-third by 2021. To implement the commitment of the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Multi-Sectoral Programme on Violence Against Women of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs, Unicef Bangladesh, Plan International Bangladesh have organized a series of workshops in division, district and upzilla levels. Government officials, NGO representatives, public representatives of local government institutions, students and teachers of educational institutions, journalist from electronic and print media, representatives of religious institutions, marriage registrars, members of citizen's groups participated in the meeting. Based on the recommendations and concerns in the workshops, a draft National Action Plan to End Child Marriage (2018-2030) was prepared.

Consultation meetings were held in the conference hall of the Department of Women Affairs on May 6, 2015 and in CIRDAP international conference centre on May 17, 2015 to review the draft Action Plan. Hon'ble Secretary of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs Nasima Begum ndc was the chief guest in the meeting. The representatives of different ministries, departments, organizations, development partners, NGOs and citizen's groups participated in the meetings. The draft Action Plan was updated on the basis of the recommendations of the meetings.

Ministry of Women and Children Affairs, Unicef and Unfpa jointly organized a workshop in Banghabandhu International Conference Centre (BICC) on 19 July, 2018 to finalize the National Action Plan to End Child Marriage (2018-2030). Hon'ble State Minister of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs Meher Afroze Chumki, MP was the chief guest and Hon'ble Secretary of MoWCA Nasima Begum ndc presided over the workshop. Necessary amendments of the Action Plan was made on the basis of the recommendations in the workshop.

The updated Action Plan was hosted in the website of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs for the public opinion and shared with major NGOs and citizen's groups for their recommendations. The draft plan was modified on the basis of those opinions and recommendations. The Action Plan was shared with different ministries and divisions for their opinion who have been identified as lead agencies and implementing partners of the Action Plan. The inter-ministerial meeting was held in the ministry of Women and Children Affairs onHon'ble State Minister of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs approved the National Action Plan.

The fiscal year 2018-2019 has been considered as base year. All the activities of the Action Plan have been categorized into short-term (2018-2019 to 2020-2021 fiscal year), mid-term (2018-2019 to 2024-2025 fiscal year) and long-term (2018-2019 to 2029-2030 fiscal year). The main objective of the Action Plan is to end child marriage by 2041. Child Marriage below the age of 15 years will be eliminated and Marriage between the ages of 15 and 18 years will be reduced to one-third by 2021. There are five implementation strategies in the Action Plan.

Meanwhile, the prevalence of child marriage has been reduced due to the initiative of the government and non-government organizations to fulfilment the commitment of Hon'ble Prime Minister which has been reflected in the Action Plan. We hope, Bangladesh will be free from child marriage before the target period with our coordinated efforts.

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Introduction:

The child marriage is violation of fundamental human rights. Because of child marriage, millions of children are being seriously affected. To accelerate the national development goals, protecting girls' rights and women empowerment are recognized as one of the most important issues all over the world. Specific directions are given on the United Nation's charter of children right and SDG5 to restraint child marriage.

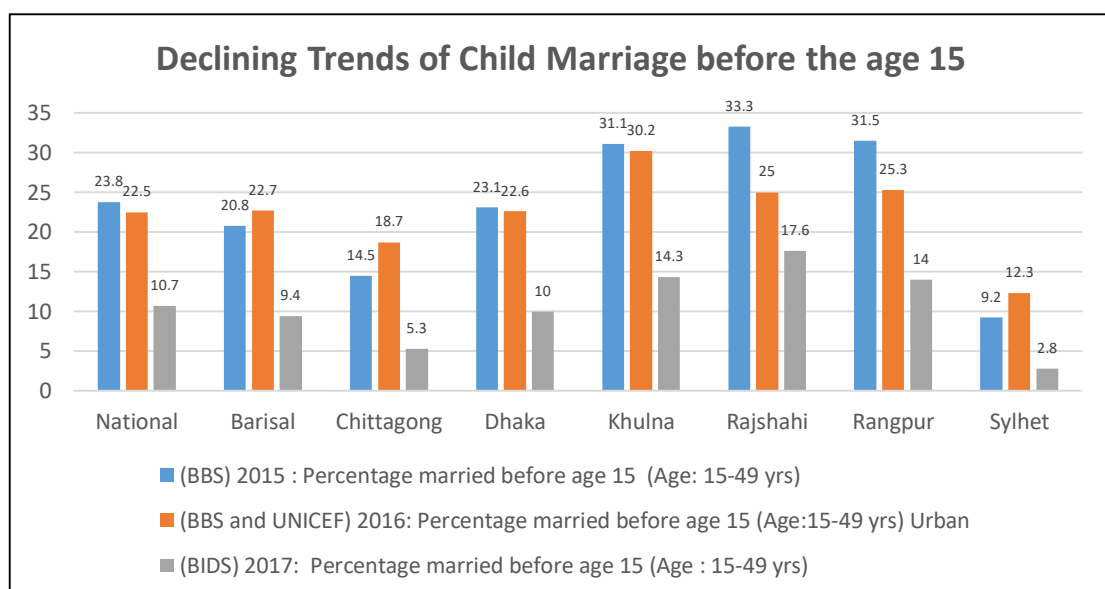
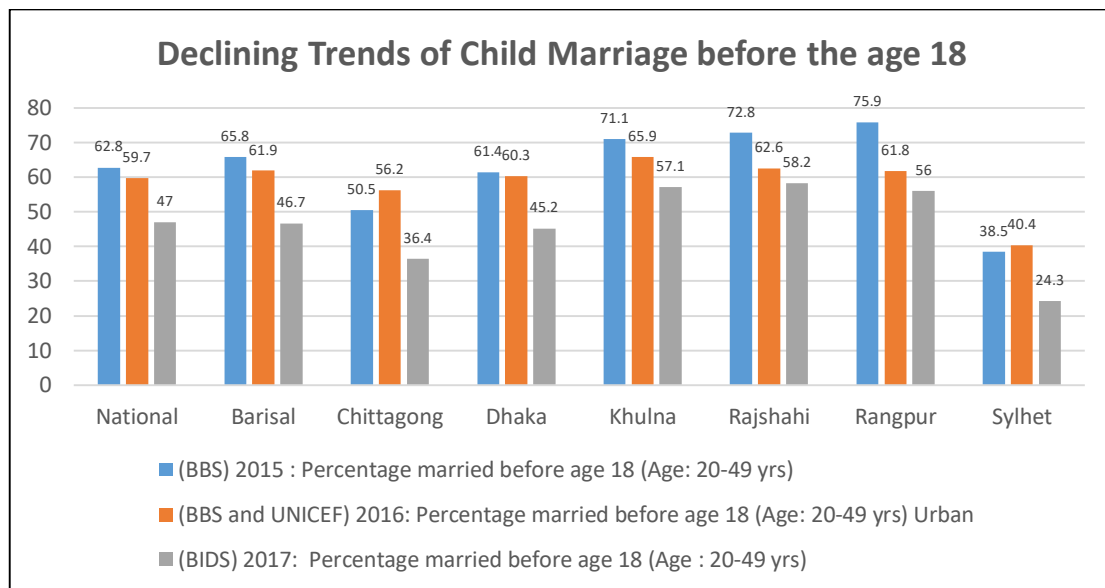
To get marriage before 18 and the effect of adolescent's pregnancy extend the existing obstruction to achieve national development goals and the empowerment of the women and girls. The child marriage violates the fundamental human rights¹ of the children and to obtain other rights.

The Government of the people's Republic of Bangladesh committed to fulfill all the commitments like the Convention on the Rights of the Child, The Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW) for empowerment of women, Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action and the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. Government has formulated the National Women Development Policy 2011, National Children Policy 2011, Children Act, 2013 and Child Marriage Restraint Act, 2017 to ensure and protect the child's rights. As per Millenium Development Goal, no 3, Bangladesh government promotes the rights to access service to ensure the participation of women in the decision-making process, violence against attitude. The achievement has been reported in the action plan of CEDAW, Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action.

The London Girl's Summit, a joint initiative of DFID and Unicef on 22 July 2014 has been given highest priority to the development of girl children. Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has made commitment in the Summit to end child marriage in Bangladesh by 2041. The child marriage below the age of 15 years will be eliminated and marriages between the ages of 15 and 18 years will be reduced by one-third by 2021. Following the declaration of the Prime Minister, a comprehensive efforts are made to formulate the national action plan.

The significant decrease of the prevalence of child marriage due to the different initiatives by the government. The Bangladesh Bureau of Statics (BBS) and Unicef Bangladesh and Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies (BIDS) conducted a survey in 2017 that shows the declining trends of child marriage in Bangladesh in recent years.

1.1 Definition of Child Marriage:

Child Marriage Restrained Act, 2017 (Act 6 of 2017) in order to the article no 2.4 "child marriage" means a marriage to which either of the contracting parties is a child; section 2.1 "minor" means a person who, if a male, is under twenty-one years of age, and if a female, is under eighteen years of age.

1.2 Causes of Child Marriage:

Reasons of child marriage in Bangladesh are follows:

- Patriarchal social system and existing social norms:** It seem that analysis the social, cultural, religious norms, family and life of women create the problem of child marriage. Girls have been often given marriage comparatively at an early age rather than boys. A young aged girl has been facing various types of pressure since she is going to adjust several social norms and customs with the society. It's social and religious duty of parents to arrange a marriage for daughter with appropriate groom according to patriarchal social attitude.

- **Poverty and economic insolvency:** Sometimes poverty-stricken parents want to get rid of financial crisis by giving their daughter marriage as early as possible. In some extend, poverty-stricken family comparatively more victim of child marriage. Sometimes poverty-stricken family try to poverty alleviation by early marriage of girl child in early age. To exchange dowry is existing social-cultural norms or customs². This situation influence much.
- **Lack of Inclusive education:** Government take different steps to ensure girl education. Besides, some girl faced in child marriage in early age on the distance of educational institution, Drop out of girl child at the ministration for lack of facilities, girls have limited opportunity to involve in vocational training and lack of area-based employment opportunity.
- **Social insecurity and fear of security:** While Bangladeshi women and girl child victimize of sexual harassment and violence, they are not easily accepted in the society as well as an aversion prevalent. Gender based violence is one of the most important reason of child marriage. Most of the time the rural areas girl victimize of sexual harassment or repression by adolescent boy or adults on the way to school or class.³ Still, many parents of rural areas seem that unmarried adolescent girls are risky to keep at home and family will be dishonored if they face of sexual harassment.
- **People's unawareness about the impact of child marriage:** Not only girl child, but also society and state are equally depreciated as a result of child marriage. Human rights are violated as well as girls are deprived of future prospects because of child marriage. Child marriage occurred due to no clear idea about these consequences.
- **Lack of Awareness on Birth and Marriage Registration:** Still people of Bangladesh have lack of awareness about Birth and Death Registration Act-2004, Muslim Marriages and Divorce (Registration) Act-1974 and Hindu Marriage Registration Act- 2012. For that reason, most of the marriage is arranged prior reaching legal age of marriage without registration.
- **Lack of implementation of Child Marriage Restraint Act:** Child marriage occurred in the society due to lack of proper implementation of Child Marriage Restraint Act – 2017.
- **Dowry impact on marriage:** Traditional idea of the society, dowry is one of the most important reason of child marriage among many other reasons in respect of the determination of marriage age.
- **Local match-makers impact on guardians:** Sometimes local matchmakers influenced on the guardians. So, without considering the future of girl child, the parents arrange marriage at an early age.

1.3. Consequences of child marriage:

- **Consequences of high reproductive health risk:** Child marriage has a risk of reproductive health which is related to the debilitate health of mother and child.⁴ Consequently, 15 and 19 years old adolescent mother is double vulnerable to death because of their impregnation and child pregnancy complication rather than 20 and 24 years old mother.⁵ Besides, 15-19 years old adolescent mothers are in the high risk of uterine cancer, fistula and sexually transmitted disease.⁶ Under the 15 years old girls are in high risk and these aged mothers

are in five times more death risk because of maternity. Children of adolescent mothers are also in severe health risk. These aged children of mothers have inadequate weight in their birth time, the baby is born before maturity and child death rate is quite high than matured mothers.⁷

- **Gender based violence:** According to UNFPA information, girls who are married under 18 years old, they are three times more victim of violence rather than 20 years old or above married girls. International report which is published by UNICEF about violence against children where we are seen that among 15 to 19 years old married girls are faced physical, sexual or mental repression by their husbands and their percentage is 47%.⁸
- **Mental health:** Child marriage depreciates the mental health of adolescent girls. As a result of child marriage, they do not physiologically prepare for taking any family as well as child bearing responsibility. Consequently, they have various psychological such as: depression, tension, unnecessary scare, cleanliness, suicide propensity etc.
- **Negative impact in respect of economic empowerment:** Child marriage hamper economic, physical and social development of girl child which deters their empowerment as well as participation in taking any decision. Consequently, their economic insolvency increased and sustainable development as well as economic growth is obstructed.
- **Polygamy and Divorce:** Child marriage, polygamy and divorce propensity is increased as a result of child marriage.
- **Population Increasing:** As a result of child marriage, girl pregnant at an immature age and becomes a mother of more child. Ultimately, the population is increasing.

2. Perspective of Child Marriage

2.1 Constitution and Legal Framework:

Collective rules and legal framework support to achieve the expected result of eliminate child marriage. According to the International law of child marriage should be consider as a criteria as define by the formulated law and principle in the bellow:

2.1.1: International Commitments and Declarations to End Child Marriage:

Bangladesh already sign in the international law, declaration and principal related to child marriage and Bangladesh government committed to proper implementation like The Universal Declaration of Human Rights, The International convention of civil and political rights (ICCPR) and The International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights (ICESCR), The Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW),⁹ The Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC), The Convention on Consent to Marriage, Minimum Age for Marriage, and Registration of Marriages.¹⁰

a) Universal Declaration of Human Rights 1948

- The Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) sets out fundamental human rights to be universally by the United Nations General Assembly on 1948. There is a rights to independence consent of marriage.
- Men and women of full age, without any limitation due to race, nationality or religion, have the right to marry and to found a family. They are entitled to equal rights as to marriage, during marriage and at its dissolution. (Article 16.a)
- Marriage shall be entered into only with the free and full consent of the intending spouses (Article 16.b).

b) Convention on the Consent to Marriage, Minimum Age for Marriage and Registration of Marriage 1964

The convention support on the principle of full freedom and consent of marriage and the consent should be in front of the proper authority. The Convention reaffirms the consensual nature of marriages and requires the parties to establish a minimum marriage age by law and to ensure the registration of marriages. However, the marriage registration by formal way, the respective authority can consider the age due to the special issue for betterment of the couple by formulating the special law and principle, it may be handicap of scheduled age.

c) Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW) 1979

- This declaration known as reserve of the fundamental rights of women. It reserve the gender equality and elimination of all forms of discrimination against women. It importance the mutual compromise among the countries to keep the rights of women.
- The signatory countries should take initiative to discrimination against women in all matters relating to marriage and family relations and ensure some issue on equality of man and women, In particular, it provides men and women with (a) the same right to enter into marriage (b) the same right freely to choose a spouse (c) The same rights and responsibilities during marriage and at its dissolution and the same rights and responsibilities as parents (Article 16.1).
- **(Not found,** Article 19.1) There is no option to engage in child marriage and childhood engagement and government should take initiative to formulate law on minimum age of marriage and mandatory of marriage registration.

d) Convention on the Rights of the child 1989

- A child means every human being below the age of eighteen years unless under the law applicable to the child, majority is attained earlier (Article 1).
- States Parties shall assure to the child who is capable of forming his or her own views the right to express those views freely in all matters affecting the child, the views of the child being given due weight in accordance with the age and maturity of the child. (Article 12.1). States Parties shall take all appropriate legislative, administrative, social and educational measures to protect the child from all forms of physical or mental violence, injury or abuse, neglect or negligent treatment, maltreatment or exploitation, including sexual abuse, while in the care of parent(s), legal guardian(s) or any other person who has the care of the child. (Article 19.1).

e) International Conference on Population and Development 1994

International Conference on Population and Development programme of Action is a milestone of gender and health development. This action consider as baseline of female reproductive health rights and development. In this case gender equality consider as influential driver of poverty, property distribution, violence, health of wome4n and adolescent which play an important role to change the attitude on female sexual and reproductive health and the reproductive health rights.

On 2014, the member countries of united nation as well as Bangladesh declare again, that International Conference on Population and Development programme of Action is solve agenda almost all the countries. The member countries again committed to move forward the programme of action.

f) Kathmandu Call for Action to End Child Marriage in South Asia 2014

The main objective of the conference of Kathmandu Call for Action to End Child Marriage in South Asia – 2014, shared vision to enjoy the rights of the children of South Asia. A part from this to ensure proper development and protection of South Asian children who got married before eighteen years old, from all form of discrimination, inequality, violence, repression, ignorance and sexual and reproductive health.

g) Sustainable Development Goal (2016-2030):

Bangladesh committed in Sustainable Development Goal-SDG after achieve Millennium Development Goal-MDG and form inter-ministerial committee to implement and monitoring the progress of the goal. As well as importantly consider the private organizations and develop a platform. It's remarkable, 5 goals directly describe the discrimination of women, child marriage, women empowerment etc. out of 17 goals. A part from this 1,2,3,4,8,11 and 16 no goal dominance the discrimination on women.

2.1.2: Acts, Rules and Plans of Child Marriage:

Bangladesh committed as democratic country to developments the rights of children and overall development of children. To establish a child friendly society Bangladesh Government formulate, approve, implement and abetment some policy and plan of action. Bangladesh Government and the development partner jointly take several activities of child marriage beside national action plan and the policy to protect child rights.

(a) The Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh :

Bangladesh Government add article in the constitution to ensure and emphasize the fundamental right of the citizen as well as the children. Some articles of the constitution clearly mention about child marriage like, emancipate of the people from all forms of exploitation Article 14, extending free and compulsory education to all children (Article 17), raising of the level of nutrition and the improvement of public health and increase the quality of education (Article 18) and positive activities for children and equality of opportunity for all citizens (Article 29).

(b) Muslim Marriage and Divorce (Registration) Act 1974

- Notwithstanding anything contained in any law, custom or usage, every marriage solemnized under Muslim law shall be registered in accordance with the provisions of this Act (Article 3).
- Where a marriage is solemnized by a person other than the Nikah Registrar, the bridegroom of the marriage shall report it to the concerned Nikah Registrar within thirty days from the date of such solemnization (Article 5.2).
- Where solemnization of a marriage is reported to a Nikah Registrar under sub-section (2), he shall register the marriage at once (Article 5.3).
- A person who contravenes any provision of this section commits an offence and he shall be liable to be punished with simple imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to three thousand taka, or with both (Article 5.4).

(c) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1980:

- If any person, after the commencement of this Act, gives or takes or abets the giving or taking of dowry, he shall be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to [five years and shall not be less than one year, or with fine, or with both] (Article 3).
- If any person, after the commencement of this Act, demands, directly or indirectly, from the parents or guardian of a bride or bridegroom, as the case may be, any dowry, he shall be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to [five years and shall not be less than one year, or with fine, or with both] (Article 4).

(d) Births and Deaths Act,2004

- The father or mother or guardian or the prescribed persons shall be liable to provide information related to birth of child to the Registrar within 45 (forty five) days of the child's birth (Article 8).

- The birth or death certificate issued under this Act shall be deemed to be one of the primary evidences of age, birth or death related information of a person to any office or court or school-college, government and non-government organization (Article 18.1).
- Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force, the birth or death certificate shall be used to prove the age of a person in the following cases:- (a) Issuance of passport; (b) Registration of marriage; (c) Admission into educational institutions (Article 18.3).
- If any person or registrar breach the articles under this Act or any rule made there under this Act, shall be punished with a fine up to Taka 500.00 (five hundred) or 2 months imprisonment or both (Article 21.2).

(e) National Human Rights Act, 2009

- To inquire, suo motu or on a petition presented by the person affected or any person on his behalf, into any allegation of violation of human rights or abetment thereof or negligence in resisting violation of human rights by a public servant (Article 12.b).

(f) Hindu Marriage Registration Law, 2012

Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law, customs and customs, Hindu marriages, for the purpose of protecting the documentary evidence of Hindu marriage, can be registered in the manner prescribed by rules (Article-3.1).

(g) Child Act, 2013

This act to implement the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child and replace the Children Act 1974. This Act improves the child's age of 16 to 18. The main articles of the act are protection of damage and conflict children, formed children welfare board, recruit police for children in each police station and adolescent court in every district.

(h) Child Marriage Restraint Act, 2017

The Act is musicality of the respective person to restrained child marriage. Child Marriage Restraint Act, 2017 (Act no 06 and year of 2017) according to the article no 2.4, "Child marriage" means a marriage to which either of the contracting parties is a child. According to the articles no 2.1 is "minor" means a person who, if a male, is under twenty-one years of age, and if a female, is under eighteen years of age.

(i) Executive Order of Ministry of Women and Children Affairs on Prevent Child Marriage.

In spite of necessary act and rules to prevent child marriage, the High Court Division of Supreme Court of Bangladesh placed a Writ (no -4781/2012) on 20, 2012, became a child marriage. The court verdict that to register the "Marriage" or "Nikah to prevent the minor marriage should verify the birth registration and National Identification Card (NID).

(j) National Children Policy 2011

The following steps shall be taken to eliminate the existing discrimination in between the male and girl child a fact in socio-economic perspective:

- Necessary rights of the female children shall be ensured for proper development of their physical and mental health (Article 8.1).
- Regular attendance of the girl child in educational institutions shall be ensured (Article 8.3).
- Necessary arrangement shall be ensured so that the girl child does not victimize of any sexual harassment, pornography and physical and mental abuses in various situation such as in the streets including inside educational institution (Article 8.4).

(k) National Women Development Policy 2011

The National Women Development Policy provide importance on the following subject:

- Stern enforcement of legislations against minor matrimony, rape of female child, abuse and repression and trafficking (Article 18.1).
- To make discrimination free treatment and put special emphases in meeting demands of female children such as, food, nutrition, health, education, sports and culture and vocational training (Article 18.2).
- Ensuring necessary rights to the proper physical and mental growth of the female children (Article 18.3).
- Elimination of all forms of discriminatory treatment and ensuring gender equality in all areas including family (Article 18.4)#####
- Ensuring regular attendance of the female children in educational institutions. (Article – 18.5)]
- Ensuring necessary measures against female children suffer no sexual harassment, pornography, physical and mental abuse in different situations such as educational institutions and in the streets. (Article – 18.6)
- Ensuring facilities to the female children for their safe and quality excursion and recreation, sports and cultural practices. (Article – 18.7)
- Eliminating discriminatory treatment to disabled female children and their security in all areas. (Article – 18.8)

(l) The National Action Plan for the Implementation of the National Women Development Policy, 2011¹¹

Course to locate vulnerable area of child marriage, and community and school based awareness camping. Develop and update a database on violence against children, child marriage, child trafficking etc. As well as integration of others database of government. (Article-18.1)

(m) The National Action Plan to Prevent Violence Against Women and Children (2013-2025)¹²

- To set up child marriage prevention Bill Board at Union Level.
- Awareness campaign with guardian meeting on sexual harassment, child marriage, drug, dowry, illegal fatwa and trafficking.
- Mass awareness on child marriage and dowry.

2.2 Initiatives for the Prevention of the Child Marriage:

- **Girl Summit, 2014:** The World Girl Summit held on 22July 2014 in London, girls is a highest priority for the government. Honorable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina committed to end child marriage by 2041, child marriage of all children bellow 15 years old will be eliminated and reduce the number of girls marriage between the ages of 15 to 18 by one third by 2021.
- **Bangladesh Girl Summit, 2014:** Ministry of Women and Children Affairs and BRAC jointly organized Bangladesh Girl Summit 2014 after the International girl summit -2014,

which is held on 22 July in London.¹³ The main object of the summit is to take effective action for women empowerment and development by the elimination of child marriage.

- **Child Marriage Prevention Day, September 29:** Bangladesh Government celebrate the Child Marriage Prevention Day from 2014 by the approval of The Prime Minister. Child Marriage Prevention day celebrated every year at Specific day of Child rights week. Ministry of Women and Children Affairs, NGOs, development partners and other organization collectively celebrate the day by organizing different programme like Meeting, seminar, workshop, human chain, rally etc.
- **Educational scholarship for the girl student of the school:** To increase the participation of girl student due to women empowerment and socio economic activities, Bangladesh government took different types of activities like girl scholarship, pay waiver benefit, financial support for purchase book, free for participate public examination from secondary to masters level. On the other hand remarkable increase the number and amount of general meritorious scholarship and vocational education scholarship for the scholar girl student.
- **Governance Innovation Unit:** Governance Innovation Unit of Prime Minister office take different initiative to determine the issue of child marriage and arrange different types of training like data base for the Marriage Register, District Register, Deputy Director of Islamic Foundation, District Women Affairs Officer and others respective officers.
- **National Helpline Centre for Violence Against Women and Children (109):** Toll Free National Helpline Centre for Violence Against Women and Children (109) play a vital role to stop and prevent child marriage. The Helpline Service Provider collect detail information from the caller like name of the candidate, father's and mother's name, detail address, name, address and phone number of the school, place of marriage, date of birth, age, date of marriage etc. After getting the information the Helpline Service Provider informed the child marriage information to District Administration, Upzilla Nirbahi Officer, District and Upzilla Women Affairs Officer, In-charge of Police Station, Chairman of Upzilla and Union, Headmaster, respective ward member, civil society, One Stop Crisis Cell and other responsible person and requested to take initiative to stop the child marriage. After that the Helpline Service Provider follow-up the child marriage until to stop. Beside this the toll free Helpline Centre provided different type of information on violence against women like legal, psychosocial, treatment, counselling, mediation, policy etc.
- **Adolescent Club (Kishore-Kishori Club):** Department of Women Affairs provide different type of life skill training among the adolescent through the adolescent club like child marriage, sexual harassment, dowry, child rights, income generating activities etc. The members of club assembled twice a time in a week and discusses on various social issues such as child marriage, dowry, violence against women and children, trafficking, drop-out from school etc. Besides, adolescents declared not to do child marriage as well as prevent the child marriage. Currently, 4883 adolescent club established in Union and Pouroshabha level.
- **Girls Not Bride Bangladesh Alliance:** This alliance established 26 organizations such as: BRAC, BLAST, Care Bangladesh, Family Planning Association Bangladesh-FPAB, Plan International Bangladesh, Population Council, ICDDR,B, Marie Stops Bangladesh, World Vision etc. The aims of the alliance is to utilization the personal experience in a platform to advocacy to empowerment of girl child and end child marriage.

- **LCG WAGE Platform** : To end child marriage Bangladesh government collectively work with public & private organization, civil society and united nations to women's development and gender equality.

3. National Plan of Action to Eliminate Child Marriage (2018-2030)

3.1. Main Principles of National Action Plan

- Ensuring Child Rights in lights of the Constitution of Bangladesh, Child Law, and International Charters.
- The state shall not discriminate against any citizen on grounds only of religion, race, caste, sex or place of birth.
- Nothing in this article shall prevent the State from making special provision in favor of women or children or for the advancement of any backward section of citizens.
- To protect the best interest of the child and to ensure the children's opinion as well as their participation in all stages of development.
- To ensure the best development for the child and the adolescent through providing necessary standard service.
- To ensure local people's participation to stop child marriage in the leadership of public representatives of local government.
- To ensure the participation of public organization, private organization, development assistance organization and civil society for preventing child marriage.

3.2 Goals and Objectives of National Action Plan

Goal:

To end child marriage by 2021 and reducing the number of girls marrying between the ages of 15 and 18 by one third by 2021.

Objectives:

To eradicate child marriage through existing institutional initiatives, current programmes and the combined effort of all within the specified duration.

Specific Objectives:

- To inform about the girl child rights to eliminate child marriage and ensuring their standard of education, reproductive health rights, nutrition, security and safe water & sanitation facility.
- To increase awareness about the formulation of laws and rules in child marriage prevention, amendment, to provide legal help to the girl victim of child marriage.
- To create awareness about the consequences of child marriage and gender-based violence and to change the existing norms and rules through ensuring the integration of people.
- To ensure juvenile's empowerment, participation, life-skill, modern facility as well as creating decision making facilities in family and community.
- To enhance the present and future Social Safety Net to eliminate the child marriage.

4. Implementation Strategies

Strategy 1: To take action to implement sector-based policies as per demand and necessity of children and adolescent.

Getting repletion of education, health and security rights of all children regardless of girl and boy is the significant achievement in the field of meaningful participation in their personal living progress, security and decision making. Social protection impact on long-term children's development which is existing from childhood to adolescent period. For this reason, it is important to adopt the implementation programme where sectoral policy is based on adolescents.

- **Implementation Strategy-1:** To ensure child marriage prevention and child rights protection services consistent with the needs of adolescents respecting sector-based policies (education, health, nutrition, industry, agriculture, save the environment, disaster management) regarding formulation, implementation, coordination, and evaluation.
- **Implementation Strategy-2:** To take initiative to increase social security for children and adolescent.
- **Implementation Strategy-3:** To ensure justice and protection related service on the victim of child marriage, violence and repression of the depreciated girl child.

Strategy 2: To ensure the law amendment, formulate policies, the implication of law and justice and accountability

Child marriage is very regular and acceptable incident in rural areas where familial or judicial rules is not congruent with the children's foremost interest and priority. Although existing minimum age determined by the established law as well as government system of marriage and birth registration, but the lack of awareness of guardian and other exceptional rules debilitate the effectiveness of law protection.

- **Implementation Strategy-1.** Strengthening birth and marriage registration.
- **Implementation Strategy-2:** Proper application of the law for the protecting the victim from the violence of child marriage and married women.
- **Implementation Strategy-3:** Ensuring awareness on law and rules and mutual coordination.

Strategy 3: To develop positive social values and norms through influence, assistance, and integration of family, society and policy-makers of child marriage prevention.

Extended network is using with success in Bangladesh as well as the information exchange for encouraging and influencing also informing effectively to the people for adopting the programmes of sustainable development. Currently, Bangladesh has faced some development obstructions (such as: using the free toilet, using safe water, extended vaccination programme, poverty eradication), similar to these proper time communication programme will be played the main role to end child marriage. Detrimental consequences of child marriage will be dealt with multi-dimensional strategy and action plan. Core tool of national action plan implementation is the successful communication programme application for the development in ending child marriage.

- **Implementation Strategy-1:** Increase community involvement to change social norms and behavior.
- **Implementation Strategy-2:** Enhancing the integration of local government into child marriage prevention programme.
- **Implementation Strategy-3:** Strengthening monitoring and skill development training for local government, community, adolescent, guardian, and policy-makers.

Strategy 4: To ensure the empowerment of adolescents for social change.

As per negative norms/attitudes, social values, gender, age and social position & status, society sustains the discriminatory relations which hampers the development of the girl child. Family and society will be jointly formulated policy and strategy for child development. Adolescent period is a development phase of the human life cycle from where they are able to ask a question and challenge to the traditional social customs and norms. So, these matters bear importance in respect of programme formulation for their empowerment. The change will come in such a kind in our society as a result of the formulated programme where girl and women will be empowered and their rights will be ensured for the empowerment of adolescents.

- **Implementation Strategy-1:** To ensure empowerment of adolescents through life skill development, practical knowledge and access to information.
- **Implementation Strategy-2:** To ensure participation of adolescents in decision-making process.

Strategy 5: To ensure digitalized education, legal and reproductive health benefits and also social protection system for adolescent and proper recreation for the adolescent girls.

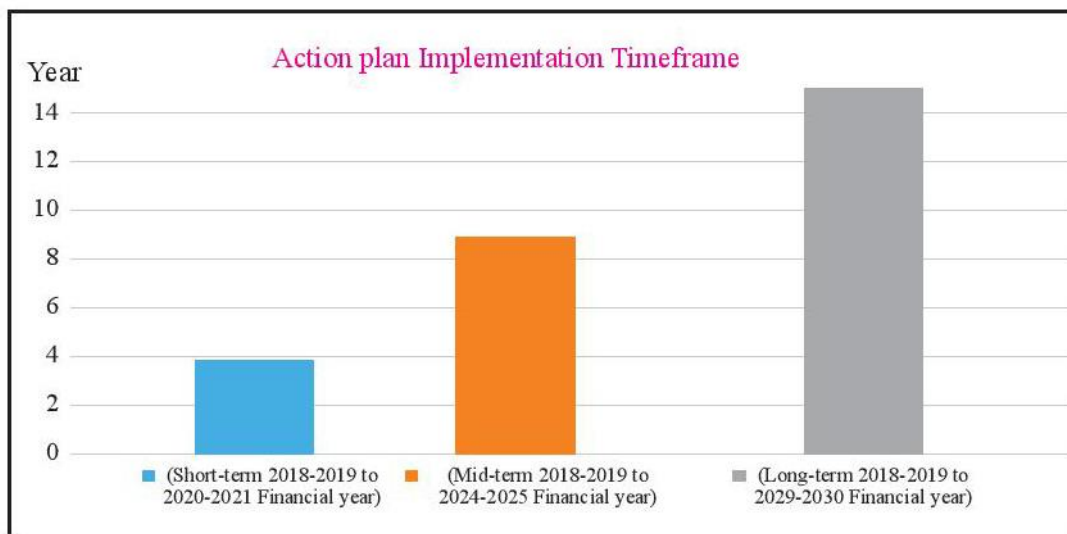
It has been already proved that the different positive effects of social safety net and social protection in respect of eradicating poverty and reducing discrimination through augmenting the presence rate in school, prevent the drop-out rate and the participation in the education programme. In respect of existing impact of these programmes on child development, the sound health of the child and gradual increasing of sound health in beneficiary regions.

- **Implementation Strategy-1:** To adopt the Social Safety Net and Social Protection Programme for the insolvent family.
- **Implementation Strategy-2:** To create educational and future employment opportunity through ensuring economic empowerment of girl adolescents.

5. Implementation Time Frame of National Plan of Action:

To take into consideration as the basis of the financial year is 2018-2019 of a national action plan for child marriage prevention in the determination of Sustainable Development Goals in 2015 by United Nations. To implement the all activity of national action plan's vision of 2021 and 2041 is declared by the Honorable Prime Minister and which has inserted following in 3 time period.

- Short-term (2018-2019 to 2020-2021 financial year)
- Mid-term (2018-2019 to 2024-2025 financial year)
- Long-term (2018-2019 to 2029-2030 financial year)



6. Monitoring and Evaluation of Action Plan

A comprehensive monitoring and evaluation framework has been included in this plan to ensure the implementation of a national action plan, to achieve the results achieved and accountability to prevent child marriage.

In the basis of the monitoring and evaluation framework, the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs, other important ministries, NGOs, development partners and donors will be able to monitor the implementation of policies and policy implementation to stop child marriage.

On the basis of the proposed strategy and desired program, the concerned authority will ensure the implementation, implementation and targets of the implementation process of the National Action Plan; The Coordinator will explain the work and responsibilities related to information collection, analysis and information management adopted by the Ministry and its partners; Establish the reporting deadline, guidelines and obligations and will take the initiative to use and publish information obtained through the monitoring and evaluation process.

The observation is to follow the information in the disciplined manner and the information against the covenant. On the other hand, evaluation is a method by which any other catalyst has influence on the plan or policy or whether the action taken in achieving the final goal is correct

7. Funding for Implementation of Action Plan

In order to ensure proper implementation of the National Action Plan, it is necessary to consider allocation of specific budget for the 7th Five Year Plan. For the prevention of child marriages, the ministry will work to monitor the resources and results by measuring the progress of implementation of proposed strategies and programs for the implementation of the proposed budget and budget indicators. Implementation of the technical skills of the designated officers as the focal points of the concerned ministry will be adopted.

8. Ministry and Organizations for Coordinating Action Plan

Promotion of child marriage, strong commitment, overlapping supervision, and implementation will enhance the progress of the government of Bangladesh. Integrated and consolidated national planning will be possible to reduce child marriage and reduce its harmful effects by using the available support, resources, skills and necessary budgets through expansion and expansion programs. Under the leadership of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs, successful implementation, monitoring and coordination of national workshops will be conducted.

8.1. Guidelines for Action Plan Implementation

Set up a Child Marriage Prevention Unit under the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs (MoWCA) to implement the national action plan and Gender Focal Person of respective ministry and department under the leadership of Secretary as well as ‘National Child Marriage Prevention Committee’ will be set up by the coordination of private organizations and the representatives of development assistance organizations. Following the responsibility of the committee.

The key responsibility of the Committees is to provide proper guidance and guidance on identifying and resolving child marriage prevention and prevention challenges. Besides, committees will undertake special measures aimed at promoting child marriages through local magazines, cable networks, billboards, posters, leaflets, documentaries, workshops, seminars, symposiums and social networking, including culture, print and electronic media, to create social awareness.

8.2. National Action Plan Implementation System

National action plan for the prevention Child marriage will be implemented by the coordination of division, Zila and Upazila administration and local government organizations under the leadership of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs. During the implementation of the planning, there has been included different government organization and different NGO, INGO, development associate including the policymakers of local level and different organizations of United Nations, civil society and religious leaders as well as adolescents.

All important issues and matters regarding the child marriage prevention have been mentioned in this guidelines; so, it will be possible to implement the national action plan through its effective application. Respective partners on the basis of the mentioned programmes of the action plan will be able to work for the prevention of child marriage.

Respective department of the government and private organizations who are working on the prevention of child marriage, they will be able to adopt their own programmes as per mentioned in the national action plan’s objective, strategy, and table. Regarding planning implementation, it is important to consider its principles and national and international law, policy and charter.

9. Participation and Roles of National and International Organizations

Elimination of child marriage is a concerted multi-dimensional attempt. Child marriage is related with the social socio-economic condition, poverty and implementation of the law, to get the proper opportunity of service and social awareness . There are various programmes of our country for the elimination of child marriage in the national and international organization and civil society. It is necessary to coordinate the cited matters of a national action plan with these programmes. A joint platform will be formed for the mutual cooperation and the concerted programme in the leadership of the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs (MoWCA). All will be responsible from side by side in acquiring the achieved goals through the monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of National Action Plan.

10. Action Plan Implementation Strategy and Activities:

Strategy 1: To take action to implement sector-based policies as per demand and necessity of children and adolescent.

- **Implementation Strategy-1: To ensure child marriage prevention and child rights protection services consistent with the needs of adolescents respecting sector-based policies (education, health, nutrition, industry, agriculture, save the environment, disaster management) regarding formulation, implementation, coordination and evaluation.**
